Uniform Dress/Hair Standards Kindergarten & Elementary School Grades K2-6

Uniform clothing should be worn to School and to all School functions, including field trips, unless otherwise stated. Uniform clothing should not be oversized or baggy. White, red, navy blue, or hunter green turtlenecks may be worn. Layered shirts that are visible must be in School uniform colors (white, red, navy blue, and hunter green). T-shirts may not be worn, including class T-shirts, sports T-shirts, and youth-group T-shirts except when non-uniform dress or School-Spirit dress is allowed. All students must maintain School uniform dress up to and including the last day of School, according to the School calendar. If a student does not wear the School's uniform clothing, he will receive disciplinary notifications and consequences, including suspension from class. Specific disciplinary measures can be found in the current Handbook and Demerit Schedule.

DRESS CODE—ALL STUDENTS

The School's uniform may be purchased from the Dennis Uniform Company or via the second-hand uniform sale on our Back-to-School Night. The Dennis Uniform Company has provided a large variety of items for our students to wear, but you do not need to purchase each one. Non-uniform accessories need to coordinate with the School uniform colors, which are **white, red, navy blue, and hunter green**. Each child should have at least one polo shirt with a Faith Baptist logo. Students will be required to wear their uniforms with our logo on all field trips.

Students may not wear the following:

1. Hats/baseball caps/stocking caps
2. Sunglasses
3. Gloves/"ski" caps (except on excessively cold or windy days)
4. Tattoos/body markings/body piercings (permanent or temporary)
5. Form-fitting or revealing clothing
6. Gang-related clothing or accessories
7. Clothing and hairstyles that are extreme or inconsistent with the religious tenets of Faith Baptist Schools (music groups, occult, etc.)

GIRLS MUST PRESENT A WHOLESOME, FEMININE APPEARANCE.

HAIR (K2–6th)—Hair should be neatly styled in ways becoming to the student's age. Unnatural hair colors or extensions, such as orange, blue, green, red, purple, etc. are not allowed. If a girl has changed her hair color to an unnatural color, she must change her hair back to its original color. Hair is not to be shaved or shaped in an extreme style.

EARRINGS—If earrings are worn, they must be a matched set. In a wide earring, the diameter is to be no more than 1¼ inches. In dangling earrings, the length should be no more than 2 inches from the bottom of the earlobe. Only one earring should be worn on the earlobe of each ear, and earrings should not be worn in places other than the earlobe. Gauges should not be worn.

BRACELETS—No more bracelets than would measure two inches on the wrist may be worn. "Noisy" bracelets are not to be worn to School.

MAKEUP/NAIL POLISH—Black nail polish and artificial (e.g., acrylics, tips, etc.) nails may not be worn.

DRESS—Uniform dress must be worn at School and at all School functions, including field trips, unless otherwise stated. Skirts must reach at least the uniform lengths indicated below. Uniform clothing must not be oversized. Turtlenecks in School uniform colors may be worn. Layered shirts that are visible must be in School uniform colors: white, red, navy blue, and hunter green. T-shirts may not be worn, including class T-shirts, sports T-shirts, and youth-group T-shirts. Color-coordinating beanies and gloves may be worn only on excessively cold or windy days. Girls may wear the Dennis skirt to classes, as long as the skirt meets the mid-knee or lower length requirement. Girls who like to climb on the equipment or tumble on the turf may wear shorts under their skirts or dresses. Non-uniform School dress may be worn to sporting events.

UNIFORM LENGTH—K3 through fourth-grade girls are to wear their dresses or skirts no shorter than 2 inches above the top of the kneecap. Fifth- and sixth-grade girls are to wear their dresses or skirts no shorter than the top of the kneecap.

TIGHTS & LEGGINGS—Tights or socks may be worn in School uniform colors only (white, red, navy blue, and hunter green). Leggings may be worn under skirts or dresses on cold days.

SHOES—Tasteful, color-coordinating athletic, casual, or dress shoes may be worn. Shoes must be laced and tied (if applicable).

JACKETS/COATS/SWEATSHIRTS—The only sweater or sweatshirt that may be worn to School is the Faith Baptist Schools' sweater or sweatshirt, the Faith Baptist sports' team outerwear, or a solid navy blue or gray sweatshirt. Other jackets may be worn to School and to and from class. Non-uniform sweaters and button-up blouses may not be worn as accessories over the uniform shirt.

NON-UNIFORM SCHOOL DAYS—Occasionally, we may have special days when costumes or casual, non-uniform dress is permitted. On these days, girls must wear dresses or skirts that are no shorter than the top of the knee. Clothing that is sheer, tight, or revealing in any way must not be worn. No shorts, mini-skirts, tube tops, pants, tank tops, or midriff-baring dresses or tops may be worn. Sundresses may be worn only if a blouse is worn underneath. T-shirts which look like undershirts or have sayings, pictures, or words which are inconsistent with the philosophy of Faith Baptist Schools may not be worn. All other regular dress code rules must be followed.

BOYS' APPAREL AND HAIR ARE TO PRESENT A CLEAN, MASCULINE APPEARANCE.

Boys are required to have short hair cuts. Boys' hair is not to hang over the ears or the collar of a uniform shirt. Hair buns and ponytails are not allowed.

HAIR (K2–6th)—Consistent with 1 Corinthians 11:14, all boys at Faith Baptist Schools are required to have short haircuts in observance of this Biblical instruction. Boys' hair is not to hang over the ears or the collar of a uniform shirt and should not be placed in a bun nor ponytail. Hair may not have any type of design, line, or symbols shaved into it. Hair that stands taller than 3" is considered too long and does not meet the School's short hair standards for boys. Mohawks are not permitted. Boy's hair is not to be shaved bald unless there is a medical necessity to do so. There should be no unnatural hair color such as orange, blue, green, red, purple, etc. If a boy has changed his hair color to an unnatural color, he must change his hair back to its original color. Sideburns should be neatly trimmed, and they should not be longer than the bottom of the ear. Facial hair, up to and including mustaches or beards, is not permitted.

DRESS—Uniform clothing must be worn to School and to all School functions, including field trips, unless otherwise stated. Uniform clothing should not be oversized or baggy. White, red, or navy turtlenecks may be worn. Layered shirts that are visible must be in School uniform colors. T-shirts may not be worn, including class T-shirts, sports T-shirts, and youth-group T-shirts except when non-uniform dress is allowed. Boys may not wear hats, hoods, stocking caps, earrings, bracelets, or necklaces. Color-coordinating beanies and gloves may be worn only on excessively cold or windy days. All boys are required to wear Dennis Uniform shorts or pants. Non-uniform School dress may be worn to sporting events. Boys are not permitted to wear nail polish or make-up of any kind.

SHOES—Tasteful, color-coordinating athletic, casual, or dress shoes may be worn. Shoes must be laced and tied (if applicable).

JACKETS/COATS/SWEATSHIRTS—The only sweater or sweatshirt that may be worn to School is the Faith Baptist Schools' sweater or sweatshirt, the Faith Baptist sports' team outerwear, or a solid navy blue or gray sweatshirt. Other jackets may be worn to School and to and from class.

NON-UNIFORM SCHOOL DAYS (BOYS)—Occasionally, we may have special days where costumes or casual, non-uniform dress is permitted. On these days, T-shirts are allowed, but tank tops may not be worn. Pants should not be excessively baggy or excessively tight. Blue jeans may be worn, but they should not be baggy or torn. T-shirts that look like undershirts or have sayings, pictures, or words which are inconsistent with the religious tenets of Faith Baptist Schools may not be worn. All other regular dress code rules must be followed. Boys are not to wear girl's clothing.
