

IMPORTANT FAITH BAPTIST DAY CAMP INFORMATION

PAYMENTS

A non-refundable \$75 application fee is due at the time of application. Weekly program day camp selections are due in full at the time of enrollment. If you registered for the Combination, Premium, or Premium Academic package, the first installment is due at the time of application; and the second installment will be auto-drafted on July 1. Any other fees and payments are also due on the first of each month and will be considered late after the first day of the month. A \$30 late fee will be added to payments made after the first of each month, and children will be required to stay home until accounts are made current. For any account delinquent past July 10, an additional \$100 late fee will be assessed each month until the account is paid in full. Faith Baptist cannot accommodate package proration. There will be no refunds given for package downgrades or for unused or missed days due to illness, vacation, etc.

DAY CAMP DATES & TIMES

Day camp is offered May 28–August 9 for students entering K3 (must turn age 3 by September 1, 2024) through 8th grade. Day camp activities are scheduled daily from 9:00 AM–4:45 PM. Early care and afternoon care is available at no additional cost from 7:00–9:00 AM and 4:45–6:00 PM respectively. However, because of our conditional use permit, we must charge \$2 for every minute per child staying after 6:00 PM. A child who is repeatedly left in day care past 6:00 PM will lose his day care privilege.

DAY CAMP FEES INCLUDE:

- All trips, including all theme parks
- Lunch every day [NOTE: Drinks are provided only on days that the campers are off campus for the entire day. Campers should bring or purchase drinks on all other days. Snacks will also be available for purchase.]
- Weekly swimming lessons
- Two Day Camp T-shirts
- Before camp care starting at 7:00 AM and after camp care until 6:00 PM

THINGS TO BRING TO DAY CAMP K3–K4 STUDENTS

Students should bring the following items with their names labeled on everything to be kept at camp and taken home once per week:

- ✓ Sunblock
- ✓ Change of Clothing
- ✓ Small blanket or Rollee-Pollee bedding for nap time
- ✓ Towel (hooded towel or terrycloth robe is ideal)
- ✓ Swim Trainer Swimsuit (Check [Walmart.com](https://www.walmart.com) or [Amazon.com](https://www.amazon.com))
- ✓ Snacks
- ✓ Plastic Water Bottle (no metal bottles please)

THINGS TO BRING TO DAY CAMP GRADES K5–8

Students should bring the following items every day in a sturdy tote bag with their names labeled on everything:

- ✓ Sunblock
- ✓ Swimsuit (Boys: swim trunks, Girls: one-piece swimsuit)
- ✓ Towel
- ✓ Flip-flops (for swim time/lessons)
- ✓ Socks (for roller skating, ice skating, and bowling trips)
- ✓ Plastic 2-pocket folder (for camp memos)
- ✓ Day Camp T-Shirt (Trip Days Only)
- ✓ Snacks
- ✓ 2-3 Plastic Water Bottles (no metal bottles please)
