

TDAP Vaccine Requirement 7th Grade Students

The 7th Grade TDAP Vaccine for students going into seventh grade is due July 1st.

By law, the State of California requires all students entering 7th grade to be immunized with a pertussis (whooping cough) vaccine booster called Tdap.

Pertussis is a very contagious respiratory disease that can be severe and last for months. The immunity received from either early childhood immunization or pertussis disease wears off over time, leaving older students and adults susceptible again to pertussis. The Tdap immunization can protect students, schools and communities against pertussis.

By law, students who do not have proof of receiving a Tdap booster shot will not be able to start school until proof is provided to the school.

Getting the adolescent whooping cough shot now will not only help protect your child against the ongoing threat of whooping cough, but will also meet the new school requirement.
