

IMPORTANT FAITH BAPTIST SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION

PAYMENTS

A non-refundable \$75 application fee is due at the time of application. Summer school-only selections are due in full at the time of enrollment. If you registered for the Combination, Premium, or Premium Academic package, the first installment is due at the time of application; and the second installment will be auto-drafted on July 1. Any other fees and payments are due on the first of each month and will be considered late after the first day of the month. A \$30 late fee will be added to payments made after the first of each month, and children will be required to stay home until accounts are paid in full. For any account delinquent past July 10, an additional \$100 late fee will be assessed each month until the account is paid in full. Faith Baptist cannot accommodate package proration. There will be no refunds given for package downgrades, or for unused or missed days due to illness, vacation, etc.

SUMMER SCHOOL DATES & TIMES

Summer school is offered June 10–July 12 for students entering K5 (must turn age 5 by Sept 1, 2024) through 12th grades. Summer school classes are scheduled daily from 8:00 AM–12:00 PM for elementary academic and junior high and elementary enrichment classes. Junior high and senior high academic classes are scheduled daily from 7:30 AM–12:30 PM. Early care is available at no additional cost from 7:00–8:00 AM. There will be no after-summer school day care provided. Summer school students who are not enrolled in or attending day camp that day should be picked up in the car line no later than 15 minutes after their last class ends. Any student waiting in the office past the 15-minute mark will incur a late pick-up fee of \$2 for every minute.

SUMMER SCHOOL ATTENDANCE:

Please review the attendance policies in the Summer School & Day Camp Handbook. Here are some brief highlights from this policy:

- Mandatory summer school students who are absent (excused or unexcused) for more than 3 sessions of an academic class may be asked to drop that class and will not receive course credit.
- Upon returning from an absence, please send your student with a written note to the School Office stating the reason for your student's absence.

THINGS TO BRING TO SUMMER SCHOOL:

- Your summer school teacher will provide a more-detailed supply list on the first day of class or in their welcome email prior to the first day of class.
- Backpack, pencils, pens (junior/senior high only), erasers, and loose-leaf notebook paper
- Water
- Snacks
- **Lunch is not provided for summer school-only students.**
